A Quick Start Guide 2022-2023 School Year

STEPS TO GET STARTED

STEP ONE

Enroll with Face by filling out the enrollment form at <https://www.faceschool.org/enrollment-form>

STEP TWO

If you are enrolled with another school contact them to withdraw your student.

STEP THREE

Begin Coursework!

- Keep track of your learning hours and the days you have learning activities. You can just jot them on a calendar or basic spreadsheet.
- We require 172 days of learning per year with an average 4 hours/day 1st - 8th grade, 2 hours avg day for kindergarten.

STEP FOUR

- Sign up for a login at Faceschool.org
- Twice a year (January & May) you will need to log in and submit a report card for your student.
- If you are not done with your semester or school year you may submit an updated report card later.

HELPFUL INFORMATION

WHAT DO I NEED TO ENROLL?

- Email, phone, and address of all past schools you would like us to request records from. We will do a formal request for transcripts for you.
- Whatever curriculum you plan to use. (If you haven't figured this out yet you may skip it and fill it in within the first month of enrollment)
- Select your service level (records only or full access)

HOW DO I WITHDRAW FROM MY CURRENT SCHOOL?

If they ask where you are withdrawing to Face is a **private school**. Enrollment with Face is legal enrollment with a private school, it is different legally than homeschool law.

YOU DO NOT NEED TO FILE A LETTER OF INTENT.

WHAT DO WE COUNT AS LEARNING HOURS?

Textbooks, worksheets, reading, or learning workbooks
Hands-on projects (including art projects)
Online classes or educational programming
In-person classes or clubs
Field trips (including active trips like skiing, hiking, etc.)
Volunteer time
Home ec & life skills training including caring for animals
Playing educational games
So much more. If they're learning it counts as learning time.

WHAT IS INCLUDED WITH MY FEES?

Records only families | Record-Keeping, ID Cards (print at home)

Full Access families | Record-Keeping, Consultations, Picture day with ID cards (local families), print at home ID cards, Field Trips, Field Day, Year-end Celebration Ceremony, Access to Classes.

(Please see our high school sheet for additional high school services.)

Service levels are per family not per student.

2022- 2023 FEES

\$75 Records only family early bird - (fees go up Sep 10th to \$85)

\$100 Full Access family fee early bird - (fees go up Sep 10th to \$110)

\$60 per 9-11th grade high school student

\$225 per senior student (Senior fees may be paid in installments. All fees must be paid in full before Feb 1st.)
